- Assist in the onboarding and orientation process for new employees.
- Main point of contact for visits by technical specialists.
- Perform daily and/or monthly audits and maintain up-to-date documentation.
- Certify laboratory test results.
- Participate in the development of proficiency testing planning and external audits.
- In collaboration with other departments and his/her manager, participate in the implementation of development projects for new methods of analysis or devices.
- Participate in the review of documentation, forms, and instrumental protocols for use in the laboratory.
- Perform analyses in the laboratory when necessary.

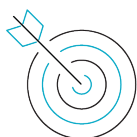

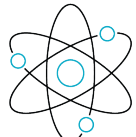

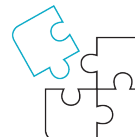
